Please note that there may be charges for items such as cemetery fees, flowers, and newspaper notices.

Basic services of Funeral Directors and staff, embalming, dressing, casketing and cosmetology, use of facilities and staff for viewing/visitation, use of facilities and staff for funeral service in our chapel, or equipment and staff services for funeral service in another facility, or graveside service, transfer of deceased to funeral home, funeral coach or funeral vehicle and utility car for flowers.

ITEMIZED SERVICE SELECTIONS

Basic Services of Funeral Directors and Staff **\$2,395.00**
Our services include, but are not limited to, attendants on-duty 24 hours a day to respond to the initial request for service, care and sheltering of the deceased, preparation and filing of the death certificate and disposition permit, consultation with the family and coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory and others responsible for final disposition of the deceased. This fee also includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs such as facility maintenance, administration, insurance etc. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).

Embalming **\$750.00**
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Refrigeration **\$350.00**
It is the policy of our firm to require refrigeration of an unembalmed deceased after 24 hours.

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony or viewing) includes, but is not limited to, basic services of Funeral Directors and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, transfer of deceased to funeral home, obtaining necessary authorizations, consents, refrigeration and crematory fee. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The container we provide is a fiberboard container. (A container for the cremated remains is not included).

TO HELP YOU UNDERSTAND

It is your right and our desire that you have as much information as possible regarding the cost of services that we offer. The most significant factors determining cost is the time spent by our personnel and the use of funeral home facilities. Personnel and facilities must be available 24 hours a day, every day of the year. Much of what we do is apparent and some is not. Traditions, social customs, personal feeling, tastes, and a multitude of other factors affect each funeral. Our services must conform to each family's personal wishes; religious, emotional and financial needs.

Our fixed overhead expenses are our monthly bills totaled for the year and divided by the number of services held that year and based on the type of service we provide. Our overhead expenses include taxes, employee salaries, building maintenance, capital improvements, stationary supplies, advertising & promotions, utilities, heat, telephone, electricity, yard maintenance, insurance-fire, theft, liability, auto, casualty & workman's compensation.

Meeting with the family to secure vital statistical information, obtain Physician's signature, file the death certificate with the registrar of vital statistics in the municipality where the death occurred, obtaining permits for burial or cremation and obtaining as many certified copies of the death certificate as necessary for the family's needs. Obtaining obituary information and providing said information to all newspapers requested by the family. Complete all necessary forms such as: Veterans Benefits, Social Security forms, and insurance claims.

Make arrangements for and coordinate times of the following services as needed: the clergy, cemetery, crematory, fraternal lodges or other organizations, military honors and others responsible for the final disposition of the deceased.

Oversee all aspects of the funeral including, conducting the funeral service according to the family's wishes, staff available to supervise the funeral service and or visitation, give out funeral information to family, associates, florists and friends, use of chapel, or equipment for church service as needed, arranging and care of flowers for best appearance.

Complete cost, depreciation, maintenance and operation for our hearses, limousines, sedans, and other vehicles needed for the families we serve.

CASH DISBURSEMENTS

This represents items that may have to be paid in advance separately. These items include, but are not limited to:

Cemetery fees: Opening and Closing of the grave. Most area cemeteries are open on Saturdays, Sundays and some holidays, but may have an overtime charge for the opening and closing of the grave on those days.

Certified copies of the death certificates: Certified copies in Texas are \$20.00 for the first copy and \$3.00 for each additional copy.

Newspaper obituaries: The local daily paper (Austin American-Statesman) has two types of obituaries. A paid obituary which may include a picture, biographical information, survivors, etc., charged by the column inch, and a brief obituary (death notice) which is published at no charge, and may include the name, age, occupation, surviving spouse or partner, date of death and service information. We will also be glad to place obituaries in out-of-town papers at your request. These newspapers may have a charge, which may be billed to the family.

Other examples of cash advance items are: police escorts, musicians, flowers, and minister honorariums.

PREARRANGEMENT & PREPAID FUNERAL PLANS

Weed-Corley-Fish Funeral Homes and Cremation Services offer two types of prearrangement plans. You may prepay for the services in advance which freezes the cost on the items you selected. The cost will never change. You may also prearrange the services you desire before the death takes place and not pay anything in advance. In this case the cost may change in the future.
